## Remarks:

- HB 108 HAMMETT TAX EXEMPTIONS** Repeals sales tax exemption for certain energy conservation property
- HB 128 HAMMETT TAX/SALES-USE, STATE** Defines manufacturer to include certain agricultural activities for purposes of the exemption for manufacturing machinery and equipment
- HB 130 HAMMETT TAX/CORP INCOME** Provides for certain organizations to elect out of partnership treatment
- HB 131 HAMMETT TAX/SALES & USE** Repeals exemption for materials used in construction of the Toledo Bend Dam project
- HB 132 HAMMETT TAX/SALES & USE** Repeals exemption for certain types of mobile, motorized equipment
- HB 156 HAMMETT TAX/CORP FRANCHISE** Specifies the amount of excess related party debt to be included in capital stock and surplus and undivided profits
- HB 513 HAMMETT TAX/SALES-USE, ST-EXEMPT** Repeals restriction on the exclusion from state sales and use tax for certain television and radio broadcast equipment which limited the exclusion to purchases mandated by the FCC
- HB 672 MONTGOMERY TAX/SEVERANCE TAX** Provides relative to oil and gas severance tax
- HB 718 BURNS TAX/SEVERANCE TAX** Provides relative to furnishing of tax information to certain state agencies
- HB 719 HAMMETT TAX/SALES & USE** Repeals certain sales tax recovery charges
- HB 721 BURNS TAX/INCOME TAX** Provides relative to the assessment of interest on unpaid income tax that interest shall be assessed for any fraction of a month
- HB 741 DURAND TAX/SALES & USE** Provides with respect to repairs to tangible personal property for use in offshore areas
