SB 187	DUPRE	<b>COASTAL RESOURCES</b> Constitutional amendment to provide that certain federal revenues received by the state generated from Outer Continental Shelf oil and gas activity shall be credited to the Wetlands Conservation and Restoration Fund and used only for certain purposes. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))
SB 195	DUPRE	<b>COASTAL RESOURCES</b> Provides for deposit into Wetlands Conservation and Restoration Fund and uses of certain federal revenues generated from Outer Continental Shelf oil and gas activity.
SB 218	DUPRE	<b>PUBLIC PROPERTY</b> Provides for the acquisition of surplus computer equipment by certain public educational institutions. (gov sig)
SB 270	MCPHERSON	<b>MEDICAID</b> Provides for the Medicaid program to develop a program to expand coverage to certain low-income uninsured through a Medicaid waiver.
SB 286	DARDENNE	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING</b> Requires legislative approval of certain cooperative endeavor agreements.
