HB 620	BEARD	FUNDS/TRANSPORT TRUST (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for state transportation infrastructure programs supported by the Transportation Trust Fund
HB 661	BEARD	TRANSPORTATION Provides for the program for construction of state transportation infrastructure
HB 669	MCVEA	BOARDS/COMMISSIONS Creates the West Feliciana Parish Port Commission

HB 698	SHEPHERD	WATER/SEWER OPERATORS Requires political subdivisions responsible for drainage to develop a formula for equitable expenditure of monies

HCR 56	HILL	HIGHWAYS Urges and requests the Department of Transportation and Development to designate a portion of La. Hwy. 10 in Oakdale, Louisiana, as the "Dr. George B. Mowad Memorial Highway"
HCR 58	MONTGOMERY	MTR VEHICLE/OFFICE Urges and requests the office of motor vehicles to inform applicants for issuance and renewal of drivers' licenses of the availability of forms to make declarations concerning life-sustaining procedures
HCR 65	SMITH, JACK	TRANSPORTATION DEPT Directs the Department of Transportation and Development to install a traffic signal at the intersection of Railroad Avenue and US Highway 90 in Patterson, La.
HB 269	BAYLOR	AIRCRAFT/AIRPORTS Increases the maximum extension of the primary term of certain airport leases
HB 270	ANSARDI	MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC Authorizes the issuance of temporary permits electronically under certain circumstances
HB 294	TOWNSEND	PUBLIC CONTRACT/BIDS Authorizes the Natchitoches Regional Airport to lease certain airport property without advertisement or competitive bidding
HB 307	FAUCHEUX	LEVEES/PONTCHARTRAIN Provides relative to the powers of the Pontchartrain Levee District
HB 346	JEFFERSON	MTR VEHICLE/REGISTRATION Provides with respect to qualifications for motor vehicle registration
HB 362	QUEZAIRE	LEVEES/BDS & DISTRICTS Authorizes the Lafourche Basin Levee District to contract for certain law enforcement services
HB 509	TRICHE	MTR VEHICLE/VIOLATIONS Provides relative to violations on an individual's official operating record
HB 671	SCHNEIDER	MTR VEHICLE/VIOLATIONS Provides relative to violations on an individual's official operating record
HB 778	HEATON	PUBLIC CONTRACT/BIDS Exempts certain airport property leases from public lease laws
