Remarks:

- HB 267 SMILEY** **ELECTION CODE** Provides relative to the number of personnel in the registrars of voters' offices and payment of certain registrars' expenses for personnel
- HB 336 WADDELL** **ELECTION CODE** Relative to voting in person, allows qualified voters to vote during a certain time period prior to the day of election and expands hours for such voting
- HB 358 LANCASTER** **ELECTIONS** Provides for a closed party primary election system for congressional offices with candidates and voters participating in a first and second primary or nominating convention according to party affiliation
- HB 415 POWELL, M.** **ELECTIONS/DATES** Eliminates the January election date for bond, tax, and other proposition elections
- HB 537 JEFFERSON** **ELECTION CODE** Relative to voting, allows qualified voters to vote during a certain time period prior to the day of election and extends time period for voter registration
- HB 37 SCALISE** **GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION** Creates an independent office of the state inspector general within the office of the governor
- HB 435 KATZ** **ADMINISTRATIVE LAW** Removes the exemption for the Department of Agriculture and Forestry in the provisions of law relative to the division of administrative law
- HB 70 TOOMY** **PUBLIC RECORDS** Authorizes the custodian to charge for copies of records provided by electronic means
- HB 115 GALLOT** **CLERKS OF COURT** Prohibits the use of privately owned copying equipment within the clerk's office
- HB 431 LANCASTER** **JUVENILES** Provides for the release or exchange of information concerning children and their families
- HB 581 TRAHAN** **CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE** Provides for privileged communications with regard to state governmental agencies
- HB 374 BRUCE** **ETHICS/CODE** Provides an exception to the post-service restrictions in the ethics code to allow a former member of the board of commissioners of DeSoto Parish Waterworks District No. 1 to be employed by the board
- HB 621 ST. GERMAIN** **ETHICS** Prohibits former members of the board of commissioners of the Louisiana Airport Authority and certain former employees of the board from engaging in

certain transactions and providing certain assistance for compensation for a period of 10 years

HB 694 DORSEY

ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS Requires legislators and candidates for the state legislature to file certain financial disclosure statements with the Board of Ethics

HB 728 CARTER, R.

ETHICS Prohibits a retirement official from accepting certain defined expenditures made by persons having or seeking certain relationships with a state or a statewide public retirement system and prohibits such persons from making expenditures for a retirement official
