| <b>HB 35</b> | <b>ARNOLD</b>  | <b>TAX/AD VALOREM TAX</b> Provides for a change of the time and date when the assessor of Orleans Parish has to complete the work on preparing and making up the assessment lists for the year 2005 (Item #42)                      |
| <b>HB 37</b> | <b>ARNOLD</b>  | <b>TAX/AD VALOREM TAX</b> Establishes certain procedures in the event of public calamity or disaster for the assessment of damaged property, the deferment of tax payments, and the extension of the homestead exemption (Item #40) |
| <b>HB 43</b> | <b>HAMMETT</b> | <b>TAX/AD VALOREM TAX</b> Provides with respect to the postponement of ad valorem taxes in parishes affected by a natural disaster (Item #42)   |
| <b>HB 44</b> | <b>HAMMETT</b> | <b>TAX/AD VALOREM TAX</b> Provides with respect to the deferment of tax payments where property subject to ad valorem taxation has been damaged during a gubernatorially declared disaster or emergency (Item #40)                  |
| <b>HB 46</b> | <b>HAMMETT</b> | <b>TAX EXEMPTIONS/HOMESTEAD</b> Provides for the continuation of the homestead exemption and special assessments when property is damaged due to gubernatorially declared disaster or emergency (Item #41)                          |
| <b>HB 64</b> | <b>HAMMETT</b> | <b>TAX/AD VALOREM TAX</b> Provides with respect to the assessment and payment of ad valorem taxes on certain damaged property (Items #40 and #42)   |
| <b>HB 65</b> | <b>HAMMETT</b> | <b>TAX/AD VALOREM TAX</b> Changes procedure for review of assessment lists and payment of ad valorem taxes for 2006 tax year and for 2005 tax year in Orleans Parish (Item #40)   |
