<b>HCR 1</b>	<b>PINAC</b>	<b>RACING/HORSE</b> Suspends the provision of law requiring minimum number of live racing days (Item #50)
<b>HCR 12</b>	<b>BRUNEAU</b>	<b>COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS</b> Urges and requests the state Office of Financial Institutions, the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, and the federal Office of the Comptroller of the Currency to provide flexibility for the modification of loan terms for entities and persons affected by Hurricane Katrina or Rita
<b>HCR 26</b>	<b>PINAC</b>	<b>RACING/HORSE</b> Suspends the provision of law requiring minimum number of live racing days
<b>HB 11</b>	<b>SMILEY</b>	<b>MTR VEHICLE/REGISTRATION</b> Provides for disposal of water damaged vehicles (Item #13)
<b>HB 13</b>	<b>PINAC</b>	<b>MTR VEHICLE/REGISTRATION</b> Provides that "total loss" water-damaged vehicles acquired by insurance companies shall not be issued a reconstructed title and shall be dismantled, crushed, or scrapped (Item #13)
<b>HB 31</b>	<b>HEBERT</b>	<b>CONSUMERS/PROTECTION</b> Provides for restrictions on contracts awarded for disaster recovery work (Item #32)
<b>HB 75</b>	<b>JEFFERSON</b>	<b>BANKS/BANKING</b> Authorizes banks to make investmests to promote public welfare in low-income communities affected by Hurricanes Katrina and Rita
<b>HB 76</b>	<b>PINAC</b>	<b>BUILDING CODES</b> Provides for changes to the State Uniform Construction Code
<b>HB 109</b>	<b>TRAHAN</b>	<b>CONSUMERS/PROTECTION</b> Makes various changes to the Unfair Trade Practices and Consumer Protection Law
<b>HB 129</b>	<b>CARTER, K.</b>	<b>MOTOR VEHICLES</b> Authorizes the use of motor vehicles declared a total loss due to disaster or emergency to be used to build reefs off the coast of Louisiana (Item #13)
