<b>HB 12</b>	<b>GREENE</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Increases penalties for failing to surrender leased movables
<b>HB 50</b>	<b>THOMPSON</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Creates the crime of unlawful picketing or protesting at funerals
<b>HB 51</b>	<b>SCHNEIDER</b>	<b>CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES</b> Amends penalty provisions of the "Pain Management Clinic Drug Abuse and Overdose Prevention Act"
<b>HB 74</b>	<b>JOHNS</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/BAIL</b> Provides for designated agent of defendant to receive written notice for appearance
<b>HB 88</b>	<b>PITRE</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Creates the crime of hit and run damaging of a potable waterline by operation of a watercraft
<b>HB 100</b>	<b>MARTINY</b>	<b>CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES</b> Expands definition of drug-free zone to include day care centers
<b>HB 220</b>	<b>GUILLORY, M.</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/VENUE</b> Provides for venue in crimes of identity theft in parish of victim's residence
<b>HB 303</b>	<b>FAUCHEUX</b>	<b>CONTROL DANGER SUBSTANCE</b> Provides relative to violations of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law in drug-free zones
<b>HB 304</b>	<b>FAUCHEUX</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Provides relative to resisting an officer
<b>HB 307</b>	<b>FAUCHEUX</b>	<b>CRIME/HOMICIDE-MURDER</b> Reduces the penalty for second degree murder
<b>HB 364</b>	<b>WALSWORTH</b>	<b>CRIME/THEFT</b> Provides for a crime of theft committed by fraudulent or deceitful means against aged or disabled persons
<b>HB 410</b>	<b>GUILLORY, M.</b>	<b>CRIME/THEFT</b> Protects persons from theft
<b>HB 512</b>	<b>MARTINY</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Creates the crime of aggravated assault with a firearm on a utility service worker
<b>HB 743</b>	<b>HUTTER</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Creates the crime of unauthorized entry of a dwelling during a disaster or emergency
<b>HB 879</b>	<b>MARTINY</b>	<b>LAW ENFORCEMENT</b> Creates crime of filing knowingly false complaints against law enforcement officers
<b>HB 1030</b>	<b>THOMPSON</b>	<b>LAW ENFORCEMENT</b> Exempts hostage situations from the state's electronic surveillance law
<b>HB 1093</b>	<b>DURAND</b>	<b>CRIME/THEFT</b> Increases penalties for oil and gas theft

**HB 1111 KENNEY**

**CRIME** Creates the crime of unlawful picketing or protesting a funeral

**HB 1125 DARTEZ**

**CRIME/SEX OFFENSES** Amends provisions of law regarding indecent behavior with juveniles

**HB 1146 TRICHE**

**ANIMALS/CRUELTY** Amends the definition of bird for purposes of animal cruelty statute to include additional species
