<b>HB 16</b>	<b>ANSARDI</b>	<b>LOCAL FINANCE/BUDGET ACT</b> Provides relative to the Louisiana Local Government Budget Act
<b>HB 38</b>	<b>CARTER, R.</b>	<b>LOCAL OFFL/POLICE CHIEFS</b> Authorizes the police chief of the city of Amite City to effect certain disciplinary actions relative to police personnel
<b>HB 39</b>	<b>CARTER, R.</b>	<b>TAX/SALES-USE, LOCAL</b> Authorizes the parish of St. Helena to levy and collect an additional sales and use tax
<b>HB 207</b>	<b>JOHNS</b>	<b>INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT/BDS</b> Provides relative to the membership of the board of directors of the Industrial Development Board of the Town of Vinton, Inc.
<b>HB 466</b>	<b>SMITH, JACK</b>	<b>DISTRICTS/DOWNTOWN DEVEL</b> Provides for recognition of the Franklin Downtown Development District as a downtown development district
<b>HB 470</b>	<b>DOERGE</b>	<b>TAX/HOTEL OCCUPANCY</b> Increases the maximum rate of hotel occupancy tax authorized to be levied by the Webster Parish Convention and Visitors Commission
<b>HB 474</b>	<b>ERDEY</b>	<b>LOCAL OFFL/POLICE CHIEFS</b> Authorizes the police chief of the town of Livingston to effect certain disciplinary actions relative to police personnel
<b>HB 492</b>	<b>HAMMETT</b>	<b>DISTRICTS/SEWERAGE</b> Increases the maximum per diem authorized to be paid to the governing board members of the Concordia Parish Sewerage District No. 1
<b>HB 493</b>	<b>WOOTON</b>	<b>DISTRICTS/SPECIAL</b> Provides relative to the Plaquemines Parish Courthouse District
<b>HB 529</b>	<b>WALKER</b>	<b>PARISH/AVOYELLES</b> Authorizes the governing authority of Avoyelles Parish to establish and collect, subject to voter approval, a mosquito abatement service charge or rates of service charges
<b>HB 625</b>	<b>SMITH, JOHN</b>	<b>TOURISM/COMMISSION</b> Changes the name of the West Louisiana Tourist Development Region to Five Parishes West and changes the parishes comprising the region
<b>HB 744</b>	<b>BRUNEAU</b>	<b>PARKS</b> Relative to New Orleans City Park, provides that the New Orleans City Park Improvement Association and its board of commissioners shall be policy-making agencies within the Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism, provides for certain other specified powers, and makes the department secretary a board member

<b>HB 751</b>	<b>GRAY</b>	<b>PLANNING/ZONING</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Requires land use and zoning regulations to include provisions for inclusionary zoning for affordable housing
<b>HB 764</b>	<b>FRITH</b>	<b>LIBRARIES</b> Transfers the administration and accounting of funds of the Vermilion Parish Library from the Vermilion Parish Policy Jury to the Vermilion Parish Library Board of Control
<b>HB 912</b>	<b>FRITH</b>	<b>FIRE PROTECT/FIREMEN</b> Provides for minimum volunteer fireman training requirements
<b>HB 915</b>	<b>HONEY</b>	<b>CIVIL SERVICE/FIRE &amp; POL</b> Provides for benefits for employees in classified fire service who suffer certain hearing loss
<b>HB 974</b>	<b>GRAY</b>	<b>PLANNING/ZONING</b> Authorizes and requires municipalities and parishes with land use or zoning ordinances or regulations to provide for inclusionary zoning for affordable housing
<b>HB 1063</b>	<b>TOOMY</b>	<b>GAMBLING/REVENUES</b> Provides with respect to the allocation of the portion of the riverboat admission fee levied by Jefferson Parish
<b>HB 1168</b>	<b>SMITH, JACK</b>	<b>SUPPLEMENTAL PAY</b> Provides relative to additional compensation authorized to be paid to certain firemen and law enforcement officers
<b>HB 1230</b>	<b>HILL</b>	<b>TAX/LOCAL</b> Authorizes the governing authority of Allen Parish to levy and collect an additional hotel occupancy tax
<b>HB 1320</b>	<b>GLOVER</b>	<b>TAX/SALES-USE, LOCAL</b> Authorizes the governing authority of certain municipalities to levy and collect an additional sales and use tax subject to voter approval
