| <b>HCR 31</b>  | <b>ROBIDEAUX</b> | <b>ATTORNEY GENERAL</b> Directs the attorney general to contact each displaced Louisiana citizen with an out-of-state address based upon the list obtained from FEMA regarding provisions of Louisiana laws which may affect such a citizen, particularly the interaction between certain income tax requirements and voter registration and voting |
| <b>HB 54</b>   | <b>TOWNSEND</b>  | <b>CRIMINAL/RECORDS</b> Provides for the destruction of arrest records in certain circumstances   |
| <b>HB 253</b>  | <b>CROWE</b>     | <b>PUBLIC MEETINGS</b> Prohibits the use of electronic communications or other means to circumvent the provisions of law relative to open meetings  |
| <b>HB 354</b>  | <b>ROBIDEAUX</b> | <b>VOTING/REGISTRATION</b> Requires the Department of Revenue to provide certain notifications to the secretary of state and provides for challenge of voter registration relative thereto  |
| <b>HB 489</b>  | <b>JEFFERSON</b> | <b>ELECTIONS</b> Changes the voter registration deadline from thirty to seven days prior to the election  |
| <b>HB 791</b>  | <b>LANCASTER</b> | <b>BOARDS/COMMISSIONS</b> Abolishes certain boards, commissions, authorities, districts, and like entities  |
| <b>HB 832</b>  | <b>SCALISE</b>   | <b>GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION</b> Creates the Office of the State Inspector General in the office of the governor  |
| <b>HB 927</b>  | <b>LAFONTA</b>   | <b>ELECTIONS/PRESIDENTIAL</b> Approves the state of Louisiana entering into an interstate compact entitled the "Agreement Among the States to Elect the President by National Popular Vote"   |
| <b>HB 1171</b> | <b>BRUNEAU</b>   | <b>PUBLIC RECORDS</b> Limits the public records exemption for the office of the governor to the executive office of the governor  |
| <b>HB 1317</b> | <b>GLOVER</b>    | <b>BOARDS/COMMISSIONS</b> Provides that no person who is appointed to a board or commission by the governor shall serve in such position for more than two consecutive terms  |
| <b>HB 1340</b> | <b>GRAY</b>      | <b>VOTERS/VOTING</b> Extends the application of provisions authorizing registered voters to vote during early voting in other parishes  |
