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| <b>HCR 5</b>   | <b>GRAY</b>      | <b>JUVENILES</b> Requests the House Committee on Criminal Justice and Senate Judiciary B to study issues related to juvenile competency  |
| <b>HB 58</b>   | <b>DANIEL</b>    | <b>PUBLIC OFFLS/EMPS</b> Prohibits public bodies from using only oral contracts with applicants for certain public positions and provides that records of such applicants are subject to the provisions of law relative to public records      |
| <b>HB 253</b>  | <b>CROWE</b>     | <b>PUBLIC MEETINGS</b> Prohibits the use of electronic communications or other means to circumvent the provisions of law relative to open meetings   |
| <b>HB 428</b>  | <b>TUCKER</b>    | <b>STATE OFFICIALS</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Establishes term limits for statewide elected officials  |
| <b>HB 489</b>  | <b>JEFFERSON</b> | <b>ELECTIONS</b> Changes the voter registration deadline from thirty to seven days prior to the election   |
| <b>HB 734</b>  | <b>LANCASTER</b> | <b>ELECTIONS/PRES PRIMARY</b> Provides relative to the presidential preference primary and other elections held at the same time   |
| <b>HB 945</b>  | <b>HONEY</b>     | <b>REAPPORTIONMENT/JUDGES</b> Provides for the election sections for the City Court of Baton Rouge and for the number of judges elected from such sections   |
| <b>HB 1088</b> | <b>MARCHAND</b>  | <b>VOTERS/VOTING</b> Requires the secretary of state to include temporary addresses for certain registered voters in the statewide voter registration database for purposes of mailing information regarding elections or voting               |
| <b>HB 1307</b> | <b>HUTTER</b>    | <b>ELECTIONS/PRES PRIMARY</b> Changes the date of the presidential primary election and elections held at the same time and the opening of qualifying for presidential candidates  |
| <b>HB 1317</b> | <b>GLOVER</b>    | <b>BOARDS/COMMISSIONS</b> Provides that no person who is appointed to a board or commission by the governor shall serve in such position for more than two consecutive terms   |
| <b>SCR 14</b>  | <b>JONES</b>     | <b>SECRETARY OF STATE</b> Directs state agencies to provide to the division of archives, records management and history locations of public records storage and directs the division to develop mapping relative to such locations.            |
| <b>SCR 15</b>  | <b>JONES</b>     | <b>SECRETARY OF STATE</b> Provides for the creation of a study committee to review and recommend a proposal for the development and location of regional records center outside of the State Archives Building and a records recovery complex. |

<b>SB 189</b>	<b>JONES</b>	<b>SECRETARY OF STATE</b> Replaces the state archivist with the secretary of state or his designee on various museum boards.
<b>SB 240</b>	<b>NEVERS (TBA)</b>	<b>WORKERS' COMPENSATION</b> Provides for practices and procedures before the second injury fund and board. (gov sig) ( <b>Subject to rules suspension</b> )
<b>SB 397</b>	<b>ELLINGTON</b>	<b>PUBLIC RECORDS</b> Prohibits the examination, inspection or copying of preconstruction estimates for certain projects advertised and let or to be advertised and let for bids by DOTD until the date for the opening of the bids. (gov sig)
<b>SB 549</b>	<b>MICHOT</b>	<b>SECURITIES</b> Provides for the confidentiality of certain records pursuant to the Louisiana Securities Law. (gov sig)
