SB 21	SMITH, MIKE	FUNDS/FUNDING Increases the portion of the severance tax on timber allocated to the Forestry Productivity Fund, from seventy-five percent to one hundred percent. (8/15/07)
SB 36	JONES	JUDGES Provides for two additional judgeships in the 4 th Judicial District Court. (2/3-CA5s15(D)) (1/1/08)
SB 82	MCPHERSON (TBA)	NURSING HOMES Provides for violations and penalties for nursing homes and health care facilities. (gov sig) (Subject to Rule Suspension)
SB 98	SCHEDLER	FUNDS/FUNDING Creates the New Opportunities Waiver Fund and dedicates certain revenues to the fund. (7/1/07)
SB 146	DUPRE	FUNDS/FUNDING Creates the Windfall Highway, Infrastructure, and Protection (WHIP) Fund and requires the deposit in the fund of certain mineral revenues in excess of the amount required to be deposited in the Budget Stabilization Fund, dedicated to certain infrastructure, hurricane protection, and coastal restoration projects. (7/1/08)
SB 187	ULLO	STUDENTS Provides relative to truancy and assessment and service centers.
SB 240	AMEDEE	COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS Requires that certain state-funded major facility projects meet energy efficient standards. (gov sig)
SB 269	FIELDS	CIVIL PROCEDURE Repeals the state's exemption from payment of costs for filing and recording legal documents and provides for payment of certain court costs by the Department of Social Services pursuant to cooperative endeavor agreements. (gov sig)
SB 299	BROOME	BESE Requires BESE to develop and implement visual arts and performing arts curricula in public schools. (gov sig)
