HB 32	RICHMOND	MORTGAGES Provides relative to the filling of a vacancy in the office of recorder of mortgages in Orleans Parish
HB 66	HARDY	ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES Requires that a sign be posted outside of alcoholic beverage outlets to notify patrons of the prohibition against possessing a firearm on premises
HB 69	RICHMOND	COURTS Requires a court to submit its request to the Judicial Council for review and recommendation when a court is requesting splitting of a court or the merging of a court
HB 93	ST. GERMAIN (TBA)	LAW ENFORCE/OFFICERS Amends provisions regarding rights of law enforcement officers under investigation (Subject to Rule Suspension)
HB 100	RICHMOND	SEIZURES/SALES Authorizes sheriff's sales at certain courthouse annexes
HB 116	JONES, ROSALIND	COURTS/DISTRICT Authorizes the 4 th JDC to provide that one division of the court shall be a DUI court
HB 126	BALDONE	CRIMINAL/VICTIMS Provides with respect to providing crime victims with recent photographs of inmates
HB 129	MONICA	COURTS/JUSTICE OF PEACE Increases the civil jurisdictional amount of justice of the peace courts
HB 130	JONES, ROSALIND	COURTS Authorizes the 4 th JDC to provide that one division of the court shall be a mental health court

HB 136	HENRY	CLERKS OF COURT Provides relative to the destruction of useless records
HB 143	CROMER	COURTS/CITY Increases the civil jurisdictional amount in the City Court of Slidell, small claims division
HB 144	CROMER	COURTS/CITY Provides for the qualification for office for the City Court of Slidell
HB 147	WOOTON	SHERIFFS Creates the Louisiana Sheriffs' Executive Management Institute
HB 426	PETERSON (TBA)	CRIMINAL/RECORDS Amends provisions of law regarding criminal background information for teachers (Subject to Rule Suspension)
HB 497	EDWARDS	CLERKS OF COURT Provides for the expenditure of the Internet access fee for the clerk of the 21 st JDC
HB 505	WOOTON (TBA)	RETIREMENT/PUBLIC SYSTEM Authorizes probation and parole officers to purchase their firearms upon retirement (Subject to Rule Suspension)
HB 530	RICHMOND	COURTS/JUVENILE Provides for the term of office for a judge with the Orleans Parish Juvenile Court in case of vacancy
