HCR 41	HARDY (TBA)	SCHOOLS Requests BESE to adopt a policy requiring certain schools to suspend all extracurricular activities for students (Subject to Rule Suspension)
HB 128	HARDY	STUDENTS Establishes minimum academic eligibility requirements for participation by certain students in interscholastic athletics and other extracurricular activities
HB 182	HARDY	STUDENTS Requires BESE to adopt rules and regulations to allow certain students to participate in graduation ceremonies
HB 353	RICHARDSON	TAX/SALES-USE, LOCAL Authorizes the Central Community School Board to levy and collect an additional sales and use tax
HB 378	ARMES	SCHOOLS/EMPLOYEES Provides relative to noncomplex health procedures performed by certain school employees
HB 671	NOWLIN	SCHOOLS/LA MATH, SCIENCE Requires the board of directors of the La. School of Math, Science, and the Arts to develop and adopt a policy for sabbatical leave for certified employees prior to the beginning of the 2009-2010 school year
HB 719	CARMODY, THOMAS	TEACHERS Provides relative to in-service training for teachers in suicide prevention
HB 871	HENRY	STUDENT/HOME STUDY Provides eligibility for certain home study students to participate in public school interscholastic extracurricular activities
HB 1069	WILLIAMS	SCHOOLS Requires the board of the New Orleans Center for the Creative Arts/Riverfront (NOCCA) to develop a plan to enter into cooperative agreements to provide educational services to students in public school systems throughout the state
HB 657	TRAHAN	SCHOOLS/EMPLOYEES Prohibits requiring school employees to complete paperwork if the

information provided for in such paperwork is available from another source

EDUCATION Requires certain school boards to provide information to certain students relative to human papillomavirus (HPV) and immunization against it
