HB 168	WOOTON	TAX/AD VALOREM TAX (Constitutional Amendment) Authorizes certain disabled persons to submit physician statements concerning the extent of the person's disability in order to qualify for the special assessment level
HB 381	CHANDLER	TAX EXEMPTIONS/HOMESTEAD (Constitutional Amendment) Increases the homestead exemption to \$15,000 and requires the yearly adjustment of such exemption
HB 416	ELLINGTON	TAX/SALES & USE Provides relative to the payment of sales and use tax rebate requests
HB 435	ROBIDEAUX	TAX COMMISSION, STATE Provides relative to certain expenses and employment of private counsel by the La. Tax Commission
HB 612	GREENE	TAX/OCCUPATIONAL Provides for an exemption from the occupational license tax for certain businesses and professions
HB 667	MONTOUCET	TAX/AD VALOREM-EXEMPTION (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for an ad valorem tax exemption for inventory and requires the state to appropriate funds to political subdivisions to offset the revenue loss
HB 683	ROBIDEAUX	TAX/INCOME TAX Provides relative to residency requirements for purposes of individual income taxation
HB 692	ROBIDEAUX	REVENUE DEPARTMENT Provides with respect to the employment of private counsel by the Department of Revenue
HB 747	ROBIDEAUX	TAX/TAXATION Provides for restrictions on the use of private auditing firms and private legal counsel
HB 749	ELLINGTON	TAX/TAXATION Requires timely payments of certain rebates and refunds
