<b>HB 24</b>	<b>GEYMANN</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Creates the crime of harboring an illegal alien
<b>HB 25</b>	<b>GEYMANN</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides for verification of citizenship or immigration status upon arrest
<b>HB 26</b>	<b>GEYMANN</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Creates the crime of unlawful transportation of an illegal alien
<b>HB 122</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>JUVENILE PROCEDURE</b> Provides for eligibility for parole for certain juvenile offenders
<b>HB 162</b>	<b>JACKSON, G.</b>	<b>SEX OFFENSE/REGISTRY</b> Provides with respect to persons convicted of carnal knowledge of a juvenile
<b>HB 234</b>	<b>GEYMANN</b>	<b>SEX OFFENSE/REGISTRY</b> Provides for the time period in which a sex offender must notify persons of their presence in the community
<b>HB 250</b>	<b>GUILLORY, ELBERT</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Amends provisions of state public defender law
<b>HB 377</b>	<b>LEGER</b>	<b>CRIME/SEX OFFENSES</b> Provides for registry of sex offender online identifiers
<b>HB 391</b>	<b>WOOTON</b>	<b>SEX OFFENSE/REGISTRY</b> Provides with respect to the failure to pay the sex offender registration fee
<b>HB 478</b>	<b>BURNS, HENRY</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Provides for resisting an officer with force or violence
<b>HB 642</b>	<b>SCHRODER</b>	<b>CRIME/SEX OFFENSES</b> Amend the criminal penalties for certain sex offenses
<b>HB 662</b>	<b>WILLMOTT</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Creates the crime of home improvement fraud
<b>HB 681</b>	<b>HUTTER</b>	<b>CHILDRENS CODE</b> Provides with respect to the duties of peace officers or probation officers upon taking a child into custody

<b>HB 682</b>	<b>HUTTER</b>	<b>CHILDRENS CODE</b> Amends provisions regarding identification of children taken into custody for delinquent acts
<b>HB 770</b>	<b>GREENE</b>	<b>CRIME/SEX OFFENSES</b> Provides with respect to the crime of computer-aided solicitation of a minor
<b>HB 777</b>	<b>RICHMOND</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides for access to DNA material if offender pays for testing
<b>HB 778</b>	<b>RICHMOND</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Extends until August 31, 2011, the period within which to file an application for DNA testing
<b>HB 786</b>	<b>PONTI</b>	<b>DWI</b> Provides with respect to penalties for offenses involving operating a vehicle while intoxicated
<b>HB 867</b>	<b>BALDONE</b>	<b>CRIME/SEX OFFENSES</b> Amends provisions of the crime of computer-aided solicitation of a minor
<b>SB 114</b>	<b>MARTINY (TBA)</b>	<b>CRIMINAL PROCEDURE</b> Amends provisions of the state public defender law. (8/15/08) <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>
