HB 3	TUCKER	ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS Requires judges and candidates for judge to disclose certain financial information (Item #1)
HB 39	ARNOLD	ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS Requires the chief law enforcement officer of a municipality to annually disclose certain financial information related to certain gaming interests (Item #1)
HB 52	PETERSON	ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS Requires the Board of Ethics and the ethics administrator to file annual financial disclosure statements (Item # 1 and 2)
HB 55	ARNOLD	ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS Requires financial disclosure by certain public servants and candidates (Item #1)
HB 8	TUCKER	PUBLIC EMPLOYEES Provides relative to the protection of public employees from threats of reprisal for reporting acts of alleged impropriety (Item #6(3))
HB 56	TUCKER	GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION Creates and provides for an independent office of state inspector general within the office of the governor (Item #6(1))
HB 27	WADDELL	PUBLIC RECORDS Limits the public records exemption for the office of the governor to the executive office of the governor (Item #5)
HB 6	TUCKER	ETHICS Provides relative to ethics education and training (Item #4 and 4(2))

HB 22	CHAMPAGNE	ETHICS/NEPOTISM Provides relative to the prohibition on employment by a governmental entity of family members of certain officials of the governmental entity (Item #4)
HB 23	LEGER	ETHICS/CODE Allows participation in the Wills for Heroes program by certain public employees (Item #4)
HB 29	TUCKER	ETHICS/BOARD Provides relative to the qualifications for service on the Board of Ethics (Item #4(4))
HB 30	ABRAMSON	ETHICS/CODE Prohibits a statewide elected official or legislator from using any thing of economic value belonging to the state or any political subdivision for certain personal use under certain circumstances (Item #4)
HB 33	PETERSON	ETHICS Provides relative to persons designated to provide information relative to ethics and conflicts of interest to public servants in certain state agencies (Item #4)
HB 59	MILLS	ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS Requires financial disclosure for all members of state boards and commissions (Item #1)
HB 64	ABRAMSON	ETHICS Requires certain elected officials to disclose certain information (Item #1)
HB 71	JACKSON, M.	ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS Provides for financial disclosure for certain public servants (Item #1)
HB 76	SMITH, JANE	ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS Provides relative to financial disclosure for certain elected officials and members of the Board of Ethics (Item #1)
