<b>HB 27</b>	<b>SMITH, JANE</b>	<b>TAX/SALES-USE, ST-EXEMPT</b> Reinstates the tax exemption for certain business utilities for all four percent of the state sales and use tax (Item #2)
<b>HB 28</b>	<b>RICHMOND</b>	<b>TAX/SALES &amp; USE</b> Establishes the Orleans and St. Bernard Recovery Zone (Item #1)

<b>HB 29</b>	<b>GREENE</b>	<b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Provides for an individual income tax deduction for certain expenses of home-schooled students (Item #7(2))
<b>HB 32</b>	<b>HENRY</b>	<b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Provides that certain federal income tax reductions shall not reduce the federal income tax deduction (Item #12)
<b>HB 35</b>	<b>FOIL</b>	<b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Authorizes income tax deductions for elementary and secondary school tuition and certain educational expenses for home-schooling children (Item #7)
<b>HB 40</b>	<b>MILLS</b>	<b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Authorizes individual income tax deductions for elementary and secondary school tuition under certain circumstances and for certain educational expenses at certain elementary and secondary schools (Item #7(1))
