| <b>HB 574</b>  | <b>SMITH, GARY</b>           | <b>SCHOOLS</b> Prohibits interactions between students and school employees in public elementary and secondary schools except in accordance with specified guidelines and limitations adopted by BESE |
| <b>HB 583</b>  | <b>RICHARDSON</b>            | <b>PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS</b> Authorizes the Central Community School Board to exchange certain property and provides procedures for approval of such an exchange                                   |
| <b>HB 775</b>  | <b>JACKSON, M.</b>           | <b>SCHOOLS/BOARDS</b> Authorizes a school board to sell or lease the naming rights of school facilities under its jurisdiction  |
| <b>HB 907</b>  | <b>BARROW</b>                | <b>SCHOOLS</b> Requires certain procedures be followed in providing access by any person to a public elementary or secondary school   |
| <b>HB 1053</b> | <b>HARRISON</b>              | <b>EDUCATION/SPECIAL</b> Provides for comprehensive revision of the educational opportunities for children with exceptionalities provisions   |
| <b>HB 1149</b> | <b>JACKSON, M.</b>           | <b>PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS</b> Authorizes the parish school board in certain parishes to name a stadium in honor of a former principal under certain circumstances                                   |
| <b>HB 1164</b> | <b>MORRIS</b>                | <b>PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS</b> Authorizes school boards to name certain buildings after living persons   |
| <b>HB 1247</b> | <b>RICHARDSON</b>            | <b>STUDENTS</b> Provides relative to the classroom placement of certain children  |
| <b>HB 951</b>  | <b>RITCHIE (TBA)</b>         | <b>SCHOOLS/EMPLOYEES</b> Provides certain requirements for the rules and policies used by local school boards for the dismissal of nontenured school employees ( <b>Subject to rule suspension</b> )  |
| <b>HB 741</b>  | <b>GUILLORY, ELBERT(TBA)</b> | <b>SCHOOLS/EMPLOYEES</b> Provides extended sick leave benefits to certain public school employees not required to hold a teaching certificate ( <b>Subject to rule suspension</b> )                   |
