<b>HB 420</b>	<b>GALLOT</b>	<b>TAX/SEVERANCE TAX</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Increases the general severance tax allocation to parishes ( <i>Technical Review Only</i> )
<b>HB 619</b>	<b>HARRISON</b>	<b>CHILDREN/SUPPORT</b> Provides for the rendering of an accounting
<b>HB 759</b>	<b>HARRISON</b>	<b>CHILDREN/SUPPORT</b> Provides with respect to a material change in circumstances in child support
<b>HB 771</b>	<b>HARRISON</b>	<b>CHILDREN/CUSTODY</b> Provides for shared custody implementation orders
<b>HB 1186</b>	<b>LABRUZZO</b>	<b>MALPRACTICE/MEDICAL</b> Reduces the amount of malpractice claims for uninsured patients
<b>HB 1219</b>	<b>LORUSSO</b>	<b>PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION</b> Provides relative to the taking of private property
<b>HB 1321</b>	<b>PEARSON</b>	<b>SUCCESSIONS</b> Allows a surviving spouse to access funds in a brokerage account prior to the naming of an executor
<b>SCR 27</b>	<b>MARIONNEAUX</b>	<b>LEGISLATIVE AGENCIES</b> Requests the Louisiana State Law Institute to study the law on successions.
<b>SB 37</b>	<b>DUPRE</b>	<b>NOTARIES</b> Authorizes certain ex officio notarial appointments by mayors in certain political subdivisions. (gov sig)
<b>SB 54</b>	<b>MURRAY</b>	<b>EXPROPRIATION</b> Constitutional amendment to remove certain restrictions on the disposition of blighted property expropriated in the city of New Orleans. (2/3-CA13s1(A))
<b>SB 138</b>	<b>QUINN</b>	<b>PRIVILEGES/LIENS</b> Provides for the cancellation of mortgages by affidavit of lost note. (gov sig)
<b>SB 182</b>	<b>GRAY</b>	<b>MENTAL HEALTH</b> Provides for assistive outpatient placement. (8/15/08)
<b>SB 265</b>	<b>QUINN</b>	<b>CHILDREN</b> Provides relative to the emancipation of minors. (1/1/09)

<b>SB 285</b>	<b>DUPLESSIS</b>	<b>NOTARIES</b> Provides that the application process to become a notary public shall be administered by the office of the secretary of state and provides procedures. (8/15/08)
<b>SB 353</b>	<b>GAUTREAUX, N.</b>	<b>LIABILITY</b> Limits liability of volunteer supervisory physicians at certain nonprofit centers. (gov sig)
<b>SB 543</b>	<b>QUINN</b>	<b>LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS</b> Provides relative to legislative continuances. (8/15/08)
