<b>HB 17</b>	<b>PEARSON</b>	<b>PARDON/PAROLE</b> Allows crimefighters organization to nominate members to the board of pardons and parole board
<b>HB 50</b>	<b>CHAMPAGNE</b>	<b>PARDON/PAROLE</b> Prohibits work release facilities located within 1,000 feet of elementary or secondary schools and day care centers
<b>HB 87</b>	<b>CARMODY</b>	<b>CRIME/SEX OFFENSES</b> Amends elements of the crime of indecent behavior with juveniles involving lewd or lascivious communications
<b>HB 104</b>	<b>SMITH, PATRICIA</b>	<b>CORRECTIONS/PRISONERS</b> Provides with respect to eligibility for parole consideration for certain elderly inmates
<b>HB 119</b>	<b>BURNS, HENRY</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/TRIALS</b> Provides with respect to testimony by simultaneous audiovisual transmission
<b>HB 171</b>	<b>HILL</b>	<b>PARDON/PAROLE</b> Authorizes certain law enforcement officers to conduct searches of certain persons on probation or parole
<b>HB 186</b>	<b>WOOTON</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/RECORDS</b> Provides for the remission and allocation of criminal history information processing fees
<b>HB 225</b>	<b>LOPINTO</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/SENTENCING</b> Amends provisions authorizing courts to sentence a defendant to home incarceration
<b>HB 274</b>	<b>TEMPLET</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Increases penalties for battery and for assault of a school teacher
<b>HB 310</b>	<b>HAZEL</b>	<b>CRIME/SEX OFFENSES</b> Amends elements of the crime of computer-aided solicitation of a minor
<b>HB 344</b>	<b>HINES</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/SENTENCING</b> Provides with respect to sentencing for the crime of aggravated second degree battery
<b>HB 346</b>	<b>POPE</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides for the method of collecting DNA samples for inclusion in the state DNA database

<b>HB 366</b>	<b>WOOTON</b>	<b>CRIME/SEX OFFENSES</b> Provides relative to monitoring of sex offenders
<b>HB 373</b>	<b>TEMPLET</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Amends provisions of law regarding expungement of criminal records
<b>HB 476</b>	<b>CONNICK</b>	<b>CRIME/SEX OFFENSES</b> Provides relative to the protection of children
<b>HB 564</b>	<b>ABRAMSON</b>	<b>CRIME/SEX OFFENSES</b> Creates the crime of trafficking of children for sexual purposes
<b>HB 588</b>	<b>LANDRY</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/RECORDS</b> Authorizes an individual to obtain a certified paper copy of his criminal history information
<b>HB 649</b>	<b>MONToucET</b>	<b>RETIREMENT/STATE EMPS</b> Authorizes a fee to be collected by DPS&C and creates the Adult Probation and Parole Officer Retirement Fund into which such fees shall be deposited
<b>HB 714</b>	<b>NORTON</b>	<b>GAMING/REVENUE</b> Provides for a promotional expense deduction under certain conditions from the definition of net gaming proceeds, net slot machine proceeds, and gross revenue
<b>HB 822</b>	<b>SMITH, PATRICIA</b>	<b>PAROLE</b> Provides relative to the Louisiana Risk Review Panel
