<b>HB 56</b>	<b>MORRIS</b>	<b>CHILDREN/CUSTODY</b> Provides restrictions in custody or visitation proceedings
<b>HB 72</b>	<b>CROMER</b>	<b>MALPRACTICE/MEDICAL</b> Revises definitions under the private Medical Malpractice Act
<b>HB 139</b>	<b>SMITH, JANE</b>	<b>CIVIL/PLEADINGS</b> Requires attachment of third-party affidavit to a petition for damages alleging negligence by an architect, land surveyor, or engineer
<b>HB 261</b>	<b>CONNICK</b>	<b>SEIZURES/SALES</b> Provides relative to the homestead exemption from seizure and sale
<b>HB 340</b>	<b>HENRY</b>	<b>RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATIONS</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to the freedom of religion
<b>HB 363</b>	<b>AUBERT</b>	<b>PROPERTY/COMMUNITY</b> Provides relative to the community property regime
<b>HB 403</b>	<b>FOIL</b>	<b>COMMERCIAL LAWS/LA.(UCC)</b> Provides relative to warehouse receipts
<b>HB 454</b>	<b>SIMON</b>	<b>PRIVILEGES/LIENS</b> Creates a statutory lien to secure the right of a farmer to crops planted on the land of another
<b>HB 502</b>	<b>CORTEZ</b>	<b>PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION</b> Authorizes the city of Youngsville to expropriate property by a declaration of taking under certain circumstances
<b>HB 509</b>	<b>LEGER</b>	<b>TAX/AD VALOREM TAX</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to ad valorem property tax sales ( <i>For Technical Review Only</i> )
<b>HB 517</b>	<b>LEBAS</b>	<b>HEALTH CARE/PROVIDERS</b> Protects persons from liability, discrimination, and employment action for refusing to provide certain health care services
<b>HB 678</b>	<b>SMITH, GARY</b>	<b>CIVIL/PROCEDURE</b> Exempts the full value of the debtor's homestead from seizure
