HB 47	HARDY	STUDENTS Establishes minimum academic eligibility requirements for participation by certain students in interscholastic athletics and other extracurricular activities
HB 179	STIAES	STUDENT/ASSESSMENT Provides relative to requirements for pupil progression
HB 193	CHANEY	SCHOOLS/FOOD PROGRAMS Provides relative to school nutrition programs
HB 308	LEBAS	STUDENTS Provides for participation in a dual enrollment program at postsecondary education institutions by certain high school students enrolled in BESE-approved nonpublic schools or BESE-approved home study programs
HB 440	BARROW (TBA)	STUDENT/ASSESSMENT Provides relative to requirements for pupil progression (Subject to Rule Suspension)
HB 496	HARRISON	BESE (Constitutional Amendment) Abolishes BESE, transfers board duties, functions, and responsibilities to the state superintendent, and provides for the superintendent to be appointed by the governor
HB 519	LEGER	SCHOOLS/CHARTER Provides relative to the fee that a chartering authority may charge a school for certain administrative overhead costs incurred by the authority
HB 531	HENRY	STUDENT/HOME STUDY Provides eligibility for certain home study students to participate in public school interscholastic extracurricular activities
HB 546	PERRY	PUBLIC LANDS/SCHOOLS Authorizes the Vermilion Parish School Board to sell certain 16 th section land with the proceeds to be placed in the Daniel R. Dartez Educational Public Trust Fund
HB 616	HONEY	STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP Permits certain students to qualify for a TOPS award based on student performance as a college freshman

HB 721	JOHNSON	EDUCATION/SPECIAL Provides relative to special educational services
HB 848	SMITH, PATRICIA	SCHOOLS/DISTRICTS Provides relative to reductions to the Recovery School District's annual appropriation for certain retiree health care costs and allocation of the amount reduced
HCR 33	LEGER	SCHOOLS/CHARTER Requests BESE to study charter school use of city, parish, and other local public school system-owned facilities
HCR 46	WILLMOTT	ATHLETICS Requests the governing authority of each public and state-approved nonpublic school to incorporate certain exercises into physical education classes and athletic training programs
