| HB 26 | LAMBERT (TBA) | FUNDS/TRANSPORT TRUST Repeals provision reducing deposits into the Transportation Trust Fund when a deficit is projected (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
| HB 289 | MORRIS (TBA) | INFRASTRUCTURE Dedicates certain mineral revenues to be used for certain local infrastructure needs (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
| HB 337 | WHITE (TBA) | FUNDS/FUNDING Dedicates mineral revenues in excess of the amount required for the Budget Stabilization Fund (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
| HB 356 | FOIL (TBA) | FUNDS/FUNDING (Constitutional Amendment) Suspends deposits of excess mineral revenues into the Budget Stabilization Fund in certain circumstances (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
| HB 497 | HUTTER (TBA) | FUNDS/FUNDING Specifies that Budget Stabilization Fund monies only be available for certain purposes (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
| HB 569 | WHITE (TBA) | ATTORNEY GENERAL Creates the Internet Crimes Investigation Fund (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
| HB 660 | SMILEY (TBA) | BUDGETARY CONTROLS Requires the reduction of authorized positions and funding in the executive budget over five years (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
| HB 661 | MORRIS (TBA) | CONSERVATION Provides with respect to the geological sequestration of carbon dioxide (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
| HB 662 | LAMBERT (TBA) | FUNDS/FUNDING Requires state sales and use tax on certain construction materials to be dedicated to the Transportation Trust Fund (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
| HB 878 | TUCKER (TBA) | APPROPRIATIONS Appropriates federal funds for hurricane related debt (Subject to Rule Suspension) |

TAX/GAMING Dedicates revenues from gaming activities to district attorneys' offices (**Subject to Rule Suspension**)

FISCAL CONTROLS Requests the Legislative Auditor, Legislative Fiscal Office, Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness, and Office of Community Development, Disaster Recovery Section to prepare a report to the legislature totaling all federal funds allocated to and expended by La. in relation to Hurricanes Katrina, Rita, Gustav, and Ike (**Subject to Rule Suspension**)
