<b>HB 90</b>	<b>JACKSON, MICHAEL</b>	<b>CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES</b> Creates the crime of the unlawful production, manufacturing, distribution, or possession of prohibited plants and adds hallucinogenic substances to Schedule I
<b>HB 91</b>	<b>WHITE</b>	<b>CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES</b> Creates the crime of the unlawful production, manufacturing, distribution, or possession of prohibited plants and adds hallucinogenic substances to Schedule I
<b>HB 121</b>	<b>MILLS</b>	<b>CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES</b> Amends the composition of schedules for controlled dangerous substances
<b>HB 130</b>	<b>WHITE</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides for procedural changes for the conducting of hearings regarding probation violations
<b>HB 173</b>	<b>TEMPLET</b>	<b>CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES</b> Creates the crime of the unlawful production, manufacturing, distribution, or possession of prohibited plants and adds hallucinogenic substances to Schedule I
<b>HB 191</b>	<b>PERRY (TBA)</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Amends provisions of the habitual offender law ( <b>Subject to Rule Suspension</b> )
<b>HB 271</b>	<b>MILLS</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Creates the crime of illegally selling urine or adulterants to circumvent screening tests
<b>HB 290</b>	<b>TALBOT</b>	<b>CRIME/SEX OFFENSES</b> Provides with respect to pornography involving juveniles
<b>HB 291</b>	<b>WOOTON</b>	<b>CRIME/SEX OFFENSES</b> Provides increased penalties for Internet solicitation of a minor resulting in actual sexual conduct
<b>HB 360</b>	<b>PERRY</b>	<b>SEIZURES/SALES</b> Provides with respect to the seizure of vehicles
<b>HB 375</b>	<b>MORRIS</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides with respect to the use of certificates of analysis in criminal cases
<b>HB 376</b>	<b>WOOTON</b>	<b>PARDON/PAROLE</b> Provides with respect to parole revocation for certain sex offenders

<b>HB 393</b>	<b>HENRY</b>	<b>DRUGS</b> Creates the crime of the unlawful production, manufacturing, distribution, or possession of prohibited plants and adds hallucinogenic substances to Schedule I
<b>HB 531</b>	<b>ABRAMSON</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Amends the elements of the crime of human trafficking
<b>HB 551</b>	<b>LAFONTA</b>	<b>CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES</b> Creates the crime of the unlawful production, manufacturing, distribution, or possession of prohibited plants and adds hallucinogenic substances to Schedule I
<b>HB 640</b>	<b>HAZEL</b>	<b>CRIME/SEX OFFENSES</b> Provides with respect to the duration of sex offender registration
<b>HB 825</b>	<b>ABRAMSON</b>	<b>CRIME/SEX OFFENSES</b> Adds the crimes of human trafficking and trafficking of children for sexual purposes to the list of sex offenses and crimes of violence
<b>HB 839</b>	<b>JACKSON, GIROD</b>	<b>CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES</b> Creates the crime of the unlawful production, manufacturing, distribution, or possession of prohibited plants and adds hallucinogenic substances to Schedule I
<b>HB 847</b>	<b>WOOTON</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Amends the crime of removing or altering vehicle identification numbers
<b>HB 908</b>	<b>LOPINTO</b>	<b>WITNESSES/CRIMINAL</b> Provides relative to the issuance of certain subpoenas
<b>HB 945</b>	<b>LEGER</b>	<b>CRIME/THEFT</b> Provides changes to the crime of unauthorized use of a movable and responsive verdicts for unauthorized use of a movable
<b>HB 1024</b>	<b>LOPINTO</b>	<b>CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES</b> Amends the crime of false representation regarding imitation or counterfeit controlled dangerous substances to include the transportation or delivery of such substances
<b>HB 1237</b>	<b>ST. GERMAIN</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Amends criminal procedure relative to witnesses called to serve in the armed forces
