HB 23	BALDONE	CORRECTIONS Revises the definition of "contraband" to include component hardware of telecommunications equipment
HB 47	WOOTON	GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER Provides with respect to the ability of state police to shut down video draw poker devices for failure to pay civil penalties
HB 77	HARDY	CRIMINAL/BAIL Prohibits a defendant's release on his own recognizance for the arrest of a felony offense
HB 138	CONNICK	CRIME Provides for restitution and disgorgement of profits
HB 161	WOOTON	GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER Amends law regarding suitability standards for video draw poker licensees
HB 162	WOOTON	GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER Authorizes the La. Gaming Control Board to adjust fuel sales requirements of qualified truck stop facilities
HB 164	WOOTON	GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER Amends provisions of law regarding advertising by video draw poker licensees
HB 286	BURRELL	CRIMINAL/BAIL Provides for a comprehensive revision of the law regarding bail
HB 533	MILLS	CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Amends time limitations for instituting prosecution for the crime of exploitation of the infirmed
HB 570	SCHRODER	BONDS/BAIL Provides with respect to the prohibition of releasing a person arrested for a crime of violence on his own recognizance or upon the signature of another person
HB 590	KLECKLEY	FIRE PROTECT/FIRE MARSHAL Provides with respect to fires of suspicious origin

HB 607	ROY	ELDERLY Provides for the mandatory reporting of abuse of adults by financial institutions and the release of financial records
HB 624	SMILEY	BONDS/BAIL Provides with respect to bail bonds and judgments of bond forfeiture
HB 664	LEGER	BONDS/BAIL Repeals provision of law regarding the prohibition on subsequent bail obligations following revocation or forfeiture
HB 762	ROY	CRIME Provides for a minimum mandatory sentence of one year for intentional acts of cruelty to the infirmed
HB 843	CHAMPAGNE	CRIMINAL/BUREAU CRIML ID Provides with respect to fees assessed for the benefit of criminalistics laboratories
HB 917	WHITE	CRIME Amends definition of "funds" with respect to the crime of money laundering
HB 940	MONTOUCET	CRIMINAL/JURY TRIALS (Constitutional Amendment) Permits criminal defendants in certain cases to waive trial by jury with the consent of the prosecutor and court approval
HB 1259	BURRELL	CRIME Creates the crime of cyberbullying
