HCR 1	FANNIN	WATER/RESOURCES Requests the Ground Water Commission to study and make recommendations on the management of the state's groundwater and surface water resources
HCR 26	HARRISON	ENERGY PRODUCTION Memorializes congress to end the outer continental shelf moratorium on oil and natural gas exploration and production
HCR 31	SMITH, JANE	ENERGY/OIL & GAS Memorializes congress to maintain the current incentives for mid-level oil and gas exploration and production
HCR 36	ROY	MINERALS/RIGHTS Provides relative to mineral rights
HCR 39	ST. GERMAIN	NATURAL RESOURCES DEPT Provides approval for the Atchafalaya Basin Annual Plan for FY 2010-2011
HB 569	CARMODY	HUNTING Provides for hunting outlaw quadrupeds and beaver
HB 726	CORTEZ	FUNDS/FUNDING Creates the Alternative Fuels Conversion Revolving Loan Fund Program within the Dept. of Natural Resources to provide financial assistance to political subdivisions of the state for the costs of purchasing or converting all or a portion of the political subdivisions' fleets of motor vehicles to qualified clean fuel vehicles propelled by an alternative fuel
HB 815	DOVE	MINERALS Provides for wells in a drilling unit
HB 837	PERRY	ENERGY/DRILLING Requires ownership signs to be placed on roads leading into the drilling site
HB 841	ARNOLD	ENERGY Provides for leases for production of hydrokinetic energy on state lands
HB 977	HARRISON	MINERALS/LEASES Provides relative to the administration and management of the state's mineral resources
HB 1164	BURNS, TIM	SAND/GRAVEL Establishes licensing and financial requirements for certain sand, gravel, and limestone activities
HB 1177	ST. GERMAIN	ENVIRONMENT/WASTE SITES Provides for the waste tire program

HCR 7	LEGER	COASTAL COMMISSION Suspends for one year the provisions of the Infrastructure Priority Program
HCR 28	DOVE	COASTAL RESOURCES Approves the FY 2010-2011 annual state integrated coastal protection plan
HCR 44	HENRY	TAX CREDITS Urges and requests the Dept. of Natural Resources and the Office of Coastal Protection and Restoration, to study the practicality and feasibility of the state authorizing tax credits for certain coastal preservation projects
HB 63	GEYMANN	PROPERTY Provides for the transfer of certain property in Calcasieu Parish
HB 310	WHITE	PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION (Constitutional Amendment) Prohibits state agencies and political subdivisions from entering into cooperative endeavors with the federal government to provide funding for the taking or damaging of lands for wetlands mitigation
HB 328	WHITE	PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION (Constitutional Amendment) Prohibits expropriation of private property for certain compensatory mitigation purposes
HB 688	FOIL	COASTAL COMMISSION Authorizes the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority and the Office of Coastal Protection and Restoration to assist in the formation of and contract with a coastal science consortium
HB 814	GISCLAIR	COASTAL RES/COASTAL ZONE Requires restoration of canals authorizes by a coastal permit
HB 844	GISCLAIR	COASTAL RES/COASTAL ZONE Provides for standards and specifications new pipelines laid in the coastal zone
HB 1020	BADON, AUSTIN	COASTAL RES/COASTAL ZONE Provide for buffer zone for borrow pits sites
HB 1090	DOVE	COASTAL COMMISSION Provides relative to various issues with the Office of Coastal Protection and Restoration
