HB 510	BALDONE	CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES Provides relative to driving offenses while under the influence of a drug and provides for definition of "drug"
SB 47	CROWE	PROBATION/PAROLE Provides for certain probation fees paid into the Sex Offender Registry Technology Fund. (8/15/10)
SB 174	SMITH, JOHN	WEAPONS Provides for training course requirements for a concealed weapons permit for combat veterans. (8/15/10)
SB 312	MORRISH	CRIMINAL JUSTICE Provides for diminution of sentence for good behavior. (10/15/10)
SB 406	MCPHERSON	CRIMINAL RECORDS Amends provisions regarding criminal background checks. (8/15/10)
SB 436	QUINN	STATE AGENCIES Allows nonprofit victim's rights advocacy organizations to nominate members to the Board of Pardons, the Board of Parole, and the Crime Victims Reparations Board. (8/15/10)
SB 502	MOUNT	CRIME/PUNISHMENT Amends the definition of "racketeering activity" to include additional offenses. (8/15/10)
SB 534	HEBERT	PUBLIC LANDS Allows the possession of firearms on certain public lands. (8/15/10)
SB 614	THOMPSON	CRIMINAL RECORDS Creates the Louisiana Arson Registry. (8/15/10)
SB 679	GAUTREAUX, B.	PROBATION/PAROLE Amends the definition of "technical violation." (8/15/10)
SB 686	MOUNT	DWI Provides relative to the forfeiture of vehicles and the allocation of monies collected from those

forfeitures involved in certain DWI arrests. (gov sig)

CRIMINAL JUSTICE Provides relative to certain adults charged for crimes committed as a child. (8/15/10)
