<b>HB 5</b>	<b>LEGER</b>	<b>PARDON/PAROLE</b> Authorizes the division of probation and parole to accept credit cards or debit cards from offenders paying probation and parole fees
<b>HB 6</b>	<b>THIERRY</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides that sentences for the crime of aggravated second degree battery shall not be suspended
<b>HB 8</b>	<b>WILLIAMS</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides for the disposal of noncontraband unclaimed property seized in certain criminal investigations
<b>HB 10</b>	<b>WOOTON</b>	<b>SUNSET LAW</b> Re-creates the Department of Public Safety and Corrections
<b>HB 22</b>	<b>BALDONE</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/CAPITAL PUNISH</b> Deletes the requirement that all witnesses to the execution of a death sentence shall be La. citizens
<b>HB 23</b>	<b>BALDONE</b>	<b>CORRECTIONS</b> Revises the definition of "contraband" to include component hardware of telecommunications equipment
<b>HB 28</b>	<b>WOOTON</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides for release on bail without proof of security under certain conditions during emergency sessions of court
<b>HB 29</b>	<b>WOOTON</b>	<b>CORR FACILITIES/JAILS</b> Prohibits the assignment of certain inmates at the J. Levy Dabadie Correctional Center
<b>HB 36</b>	<b>BALDONE</b>	<b>CORRECTIONS/PRISONERS</b> Provides with respect to the housing of certain prisoners
<b>HB 52</b>	<b>PERRY</b>	<b>PROBATION</b> Deletes provisions of law regarding the extension of parole until completion of monetary obligation
<b>HB 89</b>	<b>LEGER</b>	<b>CORRECTIONS</b> Establishes a rate of deduction regarding costs of participating in work release programs
<b>HB 95</b>	<b>WHITE</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides with respect to grand jury selection

<b>HB 105</b>	<b>BALDONE</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Amends presentence investigation provisions to include disciplinary records during incarceration
<b>HB 117</b>	<b>WOOTON</b>	<b>PAROLE</b> Amends the definition of "technical violation"
<b>HB 130</b>	<b>WHITE</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides for procedural changes for the conducting of hearings regarding probation violations
<b>HB 131</b>	<b>WHITE</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides that the grand and petit jury venire lists be made available to the public without having to be published
<b>HB 255</b>	<b>WOOTON</b>	<b>PAROLE</b> Provides for technical revision of parole statutes
<b>HB 377</b>	<b>WOOTON</b>	<b>CORRECTIONS</b> Provides with respect to malfeasance in office committed by volunteers and contract workers of DPS&C
<b>HB 608</b>	<b>WHITE</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides for the use of affidavits or other written evidence submitted by facsimile or electronic means in probable cause determinations
<b>HB 702</b>	<b>LEGER</b>	<b>JUVENILES/DELINQUENTS</b> Provides with respect to delinquency procedures
