<b>HB 104</b>	<b>HARDY</b>	<b>DWI</b> Requires a driver who is arrested for a DWI to remain in jail 48 hours after arrest
<b>SB 38</b>	<b>MARTINY</b>	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Creates the crime of participation in cockfighting. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 81</b>	<b>MARTINY</b>	<b>WEAPONS</b> Changes restrictions on statewide concealed handgun permits and adds an exception from criminal acts. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 233</b>	<b>HEITMEIER</b>	<b>CRIMINAL PROCEDURE</b> Provides for the scope of argument and charges by the court in certain criminal proceedings. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 234</b>	<b>HEITMEIER</b>	<b>EVIDENCE</b> Provides for clarifying language relative to confession evidence. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 282</b>	<b>HEITMEIER</b>	<b>CRIMINAL PROCEDURE</b> Clarifies that to qualify as a juror a person not be under indictment for, nor convicted of a felony for which he has not been pardoned by the governor. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 376</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>CRIMINAL PROCEDURE</b> Provides for confidentiality of minors who are crime victims. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 378</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>CRIMINAL PROCEDURE</b> Provides for refusal of a parent to allow a minor to be interviewed. (8/15/10)
