HCR 125	HOFFMANN	STUDENT/ASSESSMENT Requests BESE to revise the LEAP testing schedule to provide for the administration of the tests at the end of the school year
HCR 129	JACKSON, MICHAEL	HIGHER ED/BD REGENTS Directs Board of Regents to restore funding of LOUIS to at least the percentage provided for in FY 2009-2010 and expresses support for LOUIS as a critical component of the success of public postsecondary education institutions
SB 43	DONAHUE	SCHOOLS Allows chartering authorities to extend start-up time period for charter schools. (8/15/11)
SB 59	DONAHUE	STUDENTS Provides relative to the use of seclusion and physical restraint to address the behavior of students with exceptionalities.

SB 80	NEVERS	EDUCATION DEPARTMENT Provides for the reorganization of the Department of Education. (gov sig)
SB 104	LAFLEUR (TBA)	BESE Requires BESE to develop a process to certify foreign language immersion programs. (gov sig) (Subject to Rule Suspension)
SB 142	QUINN (TBA)	EDUCATION DEPARTMENT Allows charter groups to withdraw, revise, and resubmit, a charter proposal prior to consideration by the chartering authority. (gov sig) (Subject to Rule Suspension)
SB 165	WALSWORTH	COMMUNITY TECH SYSTEM Provides relative to the availability and use of electronic textbooks and other instructional material in LCTCS institutions. (gov sig)
SCR 4	NEVERS	BESE Requests BESE to establish uniform regulations regarding the purchase of used school buses for all school bus owners/operators.
