Remarks:

<b>HCR 63</b>	<b>JACKSON, MICHAEL</b>	<b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Suspends the individual income tax deduction for excess federal itemized personal deductions
<b>HB 2</b>	<b>GREENE</b>	<b>CAPITAL OUTLAY</b> Provides for the comprehensive Capital Outlay budget
<b>HB 3</b>	<b>GREENE</b>	<b>CAPITAL OUTLAY</b> Provides for the Omnibus Bond Act
<b>HB 63</b>	<b>RITCHIE</b>	<b>TAX/TOBACCO TAX</b> Removes the sunset on a portion of the tax levied on cigarettes and increases the tax on cigars, cigarettes, smoking tobacco, and smokeless tobacco
<b>HB 239</b>	<b>HINES</b>	<b>TAX/TAXATION</b> Enacts the Louisiana Fair Tax Act and repeals state taxes levied on the net income of individuals and corporations and the corporate franchise taxes
<b>HB 242</b>	<b>HINES</b>	<b>TAX/TAXATION</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Repeals provision authorizing the state to levy a tax on net incomes and adds a provision prohibiting the state from levying a tax upon the income of individuals or corporations
<b>HB 422</b>	<b>HENDERSON</b>	<b>TAX/TAXATION</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Removes the prohibition related to the imposition of an additional tax or license on gas, authorizes the levy of a tax, fee, permit, or license on natural gas transported in Louisiana, and creates the Fair Share Fund
<b>HB 436</b>	<b>HENDERSON</b>	<b>TAX/STATE</b> Levies a tax on the transportation of natural gas through pipelines in La. and provides for the disposition of the revenues
<b>HB 591</b>	<b>RITCHIE</b>	<b>TAX/TOBACCO TAX</b> Removes termination of the applicability of a certain portion of the tax levied on cigarettes
<b>HB 609</b>	<b>DIXON</b>	<b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Reduces the amount of the deduction for excess federal itemized personal deductions and dedicates the associated revenues to the Higher Education Emergency Fund

<b>HB 630</b>	<b>RITCHIE</b>	<b>TAX</b> Provides for temporary reduction of certain tax exemptions, exclusions, and deductions for support of K-12 and higher education
<b>HB 633</b>	<b>GREENE</b>	<b>TAX/CORP INCOME</b> Repeals the state tax levied on the La. taxable income of corporations beginning Jan. 1, 2012
<b>HB 634</b>	<b>GREENE</b>	<b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Repeals the state tax levied on the net income of individuals beginning Jan. 1, 2012
