| <b>HB 469</b> | <b>ANDERS (TBA)</b>    | <b>INSURANCE/SURPLUS LINE</b> Provides relative to the tax on premiums paid for surplus lines insurance ( <b>Subject to Rule Suspension</b> )   |
| <b>HB 509</b> | <b>HUTTER</b>          | <b>ELECTIONS/PRES PRIMARY</b> Changes the date of the presidential preference primary and elections held at the same time   |
| <b>HB 524</b> | <b>SMITH, JANE</b>     | <b>ELECTION CODE</b> Provides relative to procedures for registration and voting for persons in the U.S. Service and persons residing outside of the U.S.   |
| <b>HB 533</b> | <b>GALLOT</b>          | <b>ELECTION CODE</b> Makes revisions to the Election Code   |
| <b>HB 575</b> | <b>FANNIN</b>          | <b>ELECTIONS</b> Provides relative to vacancies in state legislative office   |
