HB 204	GUILLORY, M	<b>WEAPONS/FIREARMS</b> Creates the crime of reckless discharge of a firearm in a residential area
HB 220	BISHOP, WESLEY	<b>WEAPONS/FIREARMS</b> Amends penalty provisions for reckless discharge of a firearm at a parade
HB 221	BISHOP, WESLEY	<b>WEAPONS/FIREARMS</b> Amends elements of the crime of carrying a firearm at a parade

HB 982	BARROW (TBA)	<b>JUVENILES</b> Provides relative to the standards, licensing, and disclosure requirements of juvenile detention facilities ( <b>Subject to Rule Suspension</b> )
HB 1039	HARRISON	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Requires home incarceration and electronic monitoring supervision for certain convicted offenders
HB 1151	HUNTER	<b>CORRECTIONS/PRISONERS</b> Repeals authority for administrative remedy procedures in correctional facilities
HB 1152	HUNTER	<b>CORRECTIONS</b> Provides relative to pricing of items or services in correctional facilities
SB 78	MORRISH	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Amends the definition of illegal carrying of weapons to exclude certain knives. (8/1/12)
SB 255	MORRELL	<b>WEAPONS</b> Increases penalties for the crime of aggravated assault with a firearm. (gov sig)
SB 572	MORRELL	<b>WEAPONS</b> Prohibits the purchase of firearms or ammunition with the intent of transferring such to a felon whether or not the transfer to the felon ever occurs. (8/1/12)
