HB 4	LOPINTO	WEAPONS/FIREARMS Increases criminal penalties for possession of or dealing in firearms with obliterated serial numbers
HB 63	BROSSETT	WEAPONS/FIREARMS Creates the crime of reckless discharge of a firearm on a school campus
HB 204	GUILLORY, M	WEAPONS/FIREARMS Creates the crime of reckless discharge of a firearm in a residential area
HB 220	BISHOP, WESLEY	WEAPONS/FIREARMS Amends penalty provisions for reckless discharge of a firearm at a parade
HB 221	BISHOP, WESLEY	WEAPONS/FIREARMS Amends elements of the crime of carrying a firearm at a parade
HB 222	BISHOP, WESLEY	WEAPONS/FIREARMS Provides with respect to prior offenses regarding the illegal carrying of weapons
HB 261	BURNS, HENRY	WEAPONS/FIREARMS Provides relative to the exemption for law enforcement officers regarding carrying weapons in alcoholic beverage outlets
HB 290	HENRY	WEAPONS/FIREARMS With certain exceptions, reserves regulation of firearms, firearm accessories, and ammunition and related matters to the state and preempts local regulation
HB 445	LOPINTO	GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER Authorizes video draw poker device owners to hold franchise payments in trust until franchise payment is remitted to the state
HB 446	LOPINTO	GAMBLING/CHARITABLE Prohibits certain persons associated or affiliated with charitable gaming licensees from benefitting from net gaming proceeds
HB 489	LEGER	PROBATION Limits the number of active probation cases of a probation officer in Orleans Parish

HB 829	HAZEL	WEAPONS/HANDGUNS Amends concealed weapons provisions with respect to correctional officers
HB 982	BARROW (TBA)	JUVENILES Provides relative to the standards, licensing, and disclosure requirements of juvenile detention facilities (Subject to Rule Suspension)
HB 1039	HARRISON	CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Requires home incarceration and electronic monitoring supervision for certain convicted offenders
HB 1151	HUNTER	CORRECTIONS/PRISONERS Repeals authority for administrative remedy procedures in correctional facilities
HB 1152	HUNTER	CORRECTIONS Provides relative to pricing of items or services in correctional facilities
SB 78	MORRISH	CRIME/PUNISHMENT Amends the definition of illegal carrying of weapons to exclude certain knives. (8/1/12)
SB 255	MORRELL	WEAPONS Increases penalties for the crime of aggravated assault with a firearm. (gov sig)
SB 572	MORRELL	WEAPONS Prohibits the purchase of firearms or ammunition with the intent of transferring such to a felon whether or not the transfer to the felon ever occurs. (8/1/12)
