| HB 9 | LIGI | RETIREMENT BENEFITS (Constitutional Amendment) Authorizes the legislature to provide for forfeiture of retirement benefits by public officials and employees who are convicted of felony acts associated with their positions (<i>Technical Review Only</i>) |
| HB 214 | SEABAUGH | MTR VEHICLE/SEAT BELTS Repeals provision of law relative to the effect of failure to use a safety belt with regard to use for comparative negligence |
| HB 263 | HARRISON | CIVIL/PROCEDURE Provides with respect to the payment of costs and attorney fees in certain cases |
| HB 299 | HARRISON | STUDENT/TUITION (Constitutional Amendment) Exempts public postsecondary education tuition amounts and mandatory fees from requirements for imposing a new or increasing an existing tax or fee (<i>Technical Review Only</i>) |
| HB 396 | CARMODY (TBA) | HIGHER EDUCATION (Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to the powers of the public postsecondary education management boards and the Board of Regents (<i>Technical Review Only</i>) (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
| HB 409 | RICHARDSON | PRESCRIPTION Changes the prescriptive period for the enforcement of zoning restrictions, building restrictions, subdivision regulations, and use regulations in the city of Central |
| HB 468 | ABRAMSON (TBA) | PROPERTY/SERVITUDES Provides for utilities in the right of passage for enclosed estates (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
| HB 471 | ABRAMSON | PROPERTY/SERVITUDES Provides that the servitude of passage to an enclosed estate includes the right to lay utilities |
| HB 501 | LEGER | CIVIL/ACTIONS Provides for qui tam actions in cases of misuse of public funds |

HB 582	FOIL	CIVIL/ACTIONS	Provides relative to abandonment of civil actions
HB 755	HUNTER	CIVIL/PROCEDURE	Removes preemptive periods associated with disavowal and establishment of paternity
HB 840	THOMPSON, J (TBA)	CHILDREN/SUPPORT	Provides relative to suspension of licenses for failure to pay child support obligations (Subject to Rule Suspension)
