<b>HB 130</b>	<b>SMITH, PATRICIA</b>	<b>PARDON</b> Provides for qualifications of members of the Board of Pardons
<b>HB 283</b>	<b>HONORE</b>	<b>JUVENILE PROCEDURE</b> Provides relative to parole eligibility for certain juveniles
<b>HB 344</b>	<b>LOPINTO</b>	<b>JUVENILE PROCEDURE</b> Provides with respect to juvenile parole eligibility
<b>HB 531</b>	<b>HONORE</b>	<b>PAROLE</b> Reduces length of time that must be served by certain offenders before becoming parole eligible
<b>HB 536</b>	<b>HONORE</b>	<b>PAROLE</b> Changes the votes necessary to grant parole
<b>HB 566</b>	<b>BROSSETT</b>	<b>SEX OFFENSE/REGISTRY</b> Provides relative to persons convicted of crimes against nature by solicitation
<b>HB 753</b>	<b>HUNTER</b>	<b>PAROLE</b> Provides relative to juvenile parole eligibility
<b>HB 781</b>	<b>PYLANT</b>	<b>DWI</b> Authorizes the use of multiple chemical tests
<b>HB 1070</b>	<b>HUNTER</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides relative to discovery, disclosure of evidence, and sentencing reductions in criminal prosecutions
<b>HB 1100</b>	<b>BURRELL</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Amends provisions of law regarding the use of force, violence, and deadly force
<b>SB 61</b>	<b>MILLS</b>	<b>CONTROL DANGER SUBSTANCE</b> Authorizes the secretary of the Department of Health and Hospitals to issue stop order rules on certain dangerous substances. (8/1/12)
<b>SB 101</b>	<b>GUILLORY, E</b>	<b>CHARITABLE GAMING</b> Increases the number of days that games of chance may be conducted. (8/1/12)
<b>SB 130</b>	<b>CROWE</b>	<b>CONTROL DANGER SUBSTANCE</b> Includes <i>Mitragyna speciosa</i> in the definition of prohibited plant for purposes of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law.(gov sig)

<b>SB 195</b>	<b>MILLS</b>	<b>CONTROL DANGER SUBSTANCE</b> Adds phenazepam to the list of Schedule I controlled dangerous substances. (gov sig)
<b>SB 196</b>	<b>MILLS</b>	<b>CONTROL DANGER SUBSTANCE</b> Adds Ezogabine as a Schedule V controlled dangerous substance. (8/1/12)
<b>SB 303</b>	<b>RISER</b>	<b>WEAPONS</b> Constitutional amendment to require that any denial, infringement, or restriction on one's right to acquire, keep, possess, transport, carry, transfer, and use arms for defense of life and property be subject to a strict scrutiny standard by courts in determining any violation of the right. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))
<b>SB 317</b>	<b>MARTINY (TBA)</b>	<b>JUVENILE JUSTICE</b> Provides relative to parole eligibility for certain juveniles. (8/1/12) ( <b>Subject to Rule Suspension</b> )
<b>SB 456</b>	<b>AMEDEE</b>	<b>SPECIAL DISTRICTS</b> Creates a multi-jurisdictional board of commissioners to support and promote the operation of a juvenile detention facility. (gov sig)
<b>SB 462</b>	<b>AMEDEE</b>	<b>CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES</b> Delays licensure requirement for juvenile detention facilities. (8/1/12)
