| SB 59 | MORRELL | CRIME/PUNISHMENT Creates crime of utilizing or permitting the presence of a juvenile in drug trafficking. (gov sig) |
| SB 68 | KOSTELKA | DISTRICT ATTORNEYS Allows a district attorney to assess a collection fee of 20% of funds due when the amount payable to the state or to a crime victim has not been satisfied. (gov sig) |
| SB 75 | KOSTELKA | CRIME/PUNISHMENT Creates the crimes of failure to report a missing child and failure to report death of a child. (gov sig) |
| SB 121 | KOSTELKA | DOMESTIC VIOLENCE Creates the crimes of domestic abuse aggravated assault. (gov sig) |
| SB 122 | WHITE | SEX OFFENSES Provides relative to the registration of sex offenders. (gov sig) |
| SB 199 | KOSTELKA | CRIME/PUNISHMENT Creates the crime of illegal transmission of monetary funds.(gov sig) |
| SB 203 | KOSTELKA | CRIME/PUNISHMENT Provides relative to the crime of monetary instrument abuse.(gov sig) |
| SB 306 | WHITE | DWI Provides relative to cleansing period for prior DWI convictions. (gov sig) |
