HB 178	TALBOT	<b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Repeals corporation income and franchise taxes
HB 193	GISCLAIR	<b>TAX CREDITS</b> Provides relative to certain port and harbor activities for purposes of qualifying for the ports of La. tax credit
НВ 235	BADON	<b>TAX/TOBACCO TAX</b> Increases the tax on cigarettes and dedicates a portion of the proceeds of the tax
HB 271	GREENE	<b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Provides for a 10-year phase out of the state tax levied on the net income of individuals beginning Jan. 1, 2014
HB 304	TALBOT	TAX/TOBACCO TAX Increases the state tax levied on cigarettes
НВ 333	TALBOT	TAX/CORP FRANCHISE Repeals the corporation franchise tax and provisions relative to determining "taxable capital" for purposes of levying the tax
HB 338	RITCHIE	TAX/CORP INCOME Reduces the rates for corporate income tax
НВ 379	RITCHIE	TAX/CORP FRANCHISE Repeals the corporation franchise tax and provisions relative to determining "taxable capital" for purposes of levying the tax
НВ 394	RITCHIE	<b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Reduces the rates for individual income tax
HB 405	RITCHIE	TAX/SALES & USE Reduces the rate of the state tax levied on the sale, use, consumption, distribution, and storage of certain items of tangible personal property and certain services in La.
HB 417	RITCHIE	TAX/TOBACCO TAX Increases the state tax on certain tobacco products and dedicates the monies

HB 505	SEABAUGH	<b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Provides for a 10-year phase out of the state tax levied on the net income of individuals beginning Jan. 1, 2016
HB 507	IVEY	<b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Provides for a 10-year phase out of the state tax levied on the net income of individuals beginning Jan. 1, 2016
HB 536	JACKSON, K	TAX/INCOME TAX (Constitutional Amendment) Requires federal income taxes paid as a deductible item in computing state individual income tax and authorizes the deduction in computing state corporate income tax
HB 537	JACKSON, K	TAX/TOBACCO TAX (Constitutional Amendment) Levies an additional tax on cigarettes and other tobacco products and authorizes the dedication of such monies
HB 586	TALBOT	<b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Changes the rates and brackets of the state tax levied on the net income of individuals to a flat tax
HB 609	JACKSON, K	TAX/INCOME TAX Reduces the rates for individual income tax
HB 610	TALBOT	TAX/SALES-USE, STATE Provides relative to services subject to the state sales and use tax
HB 623	JACKSON, K	TAX/TOBACCO TAX Increases the state tax on certain tobacco products
HB 626	JACKSON, K	<b>TAX/CORP INCOME</b> Reduces the rate for corporate income tax and repeals corporate franchise taxes and federal deductions allowed on net state corporate income tax
HB 632	IVEY	<b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Provides for a 5-year phase out of the state tax levied on the net income of individuals and includes special provisions relating to persons age 65 and older
HB 634	SEABAUGH	<b>TAX/CORP INCOME</b> Phases out corporation income and corporation franchise taxes over a 10-year period
HB 637	IVEY	TAX/CORP INCOME Phases out the state corporation income and franchise taxes over three years
HB 640	GREENE	<b>TAX/CORP INCOME</b> Phases-out corporation income and corporation franchise taxes over a 10-year period
HB 669	TALBOT	<b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Provides for a six-year phase out of the state tax levied on the net income of individuals beginning Jan. 1, 2015
