<b>HB 267</b>	<b>HENSGENS</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/HIGH SCHOOL</b> Prohibits public high school participation in interscholastic athletics regulated by any association that discriminates among schools based on school admissions criteria in classifying schools into divisions for competition
<b>HB 116</b>	<b>HOFFMANN</b>	<b>TEXTBOOKS/MATERIALS</b> Provides relative to textbooks and other instructional materials for elementary and secondary schools
<b>HB 659</b>	<b>THOMPSON, J</b>	<b>EDUCATION</b> Provides relative to reporting, instructional, and other requirements for school employees, school governing authorities, and schools
<b>HB 214</b>	<b>JEFFERSON</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/PARENTS</b> Provides relative to parental involvement in public schools
<b>HB 242</b>	<b>CARTER</b>	<b>STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP</b> Authorizes the state superintendent of education to make certain adjustments to the Student Scholarships for Educational Excellence Program accountability system
<b>HB 368</b>	<b>NORTON</b>	<b>SCHOOLS</b> Provides relative to school crisis management and response plans and school resource officers
<b>HCR 91</b>	<b>SMITH, PATRICIA (TBA)</b>	<b>STUDENT/DISCIPLINE</b> Creates the Task Force on Bullying Prevention in Public Schools to study the procedures and processes by which incidents of bullying are reported and investigated <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>
