| <b>SB 27</b>  | <b>BROOME</b>      | <b>SEIZURES/SALES</b> Provides for the Louisiana Home Protection Act. (8/1/13)   |
| <b>SB 56</b>  | <b>MORRELL</b>     | <b>TAX/AD VALOREM</b> Constitutional amendment to exclude owners who are permanently totally disabled from the requirement that they annually certify to the assessor the amount of their adjusted gross income in order to receive the Special Assessment Level. (1/1/15) (2/3-CA13s1(A)) |
| <b>SB 73</b>  | <b>WHITE</b>       | <b>SCHOOLS</b> Constitutional amendment to grant the Southeast Baton Rouge community school system in East Baton Rouge Parish the same authority granted parishes relative to MFP funding and raising revenue for schools. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))   |
| <b>SB 96</b>  | <b>ADLEY (TBA)</b> | <b>TAX/AD VALOREM</b> Constitutional amendment to provide for eligibility for disabled veterans and their spouses for certain exemptions from ad valorem taxes. (2/3 - CA13s1(A)) <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>  |
| <b>SB 156</b> | <b>BROOME</b>      | <b>LEASES</b> Provides relative to leases and multi-family residential dwelling lessees' right to notification of foreclosure action. (8/1/13)   |
