_____	<b>HCR 107</b>	<b>HUNTER</b>	<b>JOINT RULES</b> Provides relative to bills that contain only technical amendments to provisions of law
_____	<b>HB 112</b>	<b>RICHARD</b>	<b>LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to the length of regular sessions in odd-numbered years and the consideration of certain measures in such sessions
_____	<b>HB 313</b>	<b>CHAMPAGNE</b>	<b>ELECTED OFFICIALS/TERMS</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides term limits for certain statewide elected officials

_____	<b>HB 452</b>	<b>TALBOT</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Prohibits public servants from engaging in certain activities with public funds and assets
_____	<b>HB 870</b>	<b>RICHARD</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Prohibits certain transactions involving charter schools
_____	<b>HB 909</b>	<b>LEOPOLD</b>	<b>INSURANCE</b> Provides for the Property Insurance Clarity Act
_____	<b>HB 1090</b>	<b>HOLLIS</b>	<b>HEALTH CARE</b> Provides relative to the Interstate Health Care Compact
_____	<b>HB 1102</b>	<b>CHAMPAGNE</b>	<b>ELECTED OFFICIALS</b> Prohibits use of public funds for certain advertisements
_____	<b>HB 1168</b>	<b>NORTON</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides an exception to allow certain elected officials who serve on the board of a nonprofit organization to participate in transactions involving the governmental entity and the nonprofit organization
_____	<b>HB 1185</b>	<b>HUNTER</b>	<b>SUNSET LAW</b> Provides relative to legislation re-creating statutory entities
_____	<b>HB 1226</b>	<b>NORTON</b>	<b>ELECTED OFFICIALS</b> Requires a former elected official to remove certain signs and avoid using certain letterhead following the termination of the holding of elected public office
