_____	HB 148	CHAMPAGNE	FUNDS/FUNDING (Constitutional Amendment) Requires that monies received by the state from violations of certain federal and state laws associated with the Deepwater Horizon oil spill be deposited into the Coastal Protection and Restoration Fund
_____	HB 176	BROWN, TERRY	FUNDS/FUNDING Dedicates the proceeds of the state sales tax collected on hotel occupancy tax in Grant Parish to the Grant Parish Economic Development Fund
_____	HB 262	FANNIN	APPROPRIATIONS/ANCILLARY Provides for ancillary expenses of state government
_____	HB 343	HARRISON	ELDERLY (Constitutional Amendment) Creates and provides for a Department of Elderly Affairs
