_____	<b>HB 452</b>	<b>TALBOT</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Prohibits public servants from engaging in certain activities with public funds and assets
_____	<b>HB 923</b>	<b>IVEY</b>	<b>MUNICIPALITIES</b> Requires governing authorities of parishes and municipalities to make meeting agendas, minutes, and votes available on the Internet
_____	<b>SB 43</b>	<b>BROOME</b>	<b>LEGISLATIVE AGENCIES</b> Revises youth membership and staffing for the Legislative Youth Advisory Council. (8/1/14)
_____	<b>SB 60</b>	<b>GALLOT</b>	<b>VOTERS/VOTING</b> Removes prohibition of recognition of an Independent party. (1/1/15)
_____	<b>SB 161</b>	<b>MURRAY</b>	<b>LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS</b> Provides relative to restitution of audit costs. (8/1/14)
_____	<b>SB 180</b>	<b>GALLOT</b>	<b>LEGISLATION</b> Provides for the recommending by the Louisiana State Law Institute of repeal, removal or revision of law that has been declared unconstitutional by final and definitive court judgment. (gov sig)

_____	<b>SB 208</b>	<b>WARD</b>	<b>ELECTION CODE</b> Prohibits a public officer who has been removed from office pursuant to a recall election from qualifying for the same office at a special election to fill the position. (8/1/14)
_____	<b>SB 220</b>	<b>MURRAY</b>	<b>LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS</b> Provides relative to notification of the legislative auditor and district attorney. (8/1/14)
_____	<b>SB 224</b>	<b>MURRAY</b>	<b>LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS</b> Provides relative to the posting of auditor notices. (8/1/14)
_____	<b>SB 235</b>	<b>ALLAIN</b>	<b>TAX/LOCAL</b> Requires written or emailed notice of a meeting concerning tax measures to be provided to certain officials and excludes certain meetings of political subdivisions concerning tax measures from certain notice requirements. (1/1/15)
_____	<b>SB 319</b>	<b>DONAHUE</b>	<b>FISCAL CONTROLS</b> Provides that certain audits completed by the office of the legislative auditor shall be reported to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget on an annual basis. (7/1/14)
_____	<b>SB 386</b>	<b>LAFLEUR</b>	<b>FISCAL CONTROLS</b> Provides relative to audits by the legislative auditor. (8/1/14)
_____	<b>SB 460</b>	<b>ADLEY</b>	<b>LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR</b> Requires schools receiving certain state scholarship funds to maintain funds in a separate account or use certain accounting procedures established for the legislative auditor. (8/1/14)
_____	<b>SB 593</b>	<b>CROWE</b>	<b>MUNICIPALITIES</b> Limits the number of terms of office of any elected official of certain municipalities. (gov sig)
_____	<b>SB 642</b>	<b>CROWE</b>	<b>LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR</b> Increases annual audit requirements for certain entities in certain parishes. (8/1/14)
