_____	<b>HB 947</b>	<b>HAVARD</b>	<b>TEACHERS/EVALUATION</b> Lowers the required percentage of a teacher's evaluation that is based on growth in student achievement using a value-added assessment model and provides for weighted application of evaluation elements in the calculation of evaluation results
_____	<b>SCR 95</b>	<b>HEITMEIER</b>	<b>EDUCATION DEPARTMENT</b> Requests the Department of Education to issue a report as to the number of joint-use agreements in place throughout the state and include a plan to promote the use of such agreements.
_____	<b>SCR 96</b>	<b>HEITMEIER</b>	<b>EDUCATION DEPARTMENT</b> Requests the Department of Education to submit a report to the Legislature regarding the availability of water for student consumption at elementary and secondary schools.
_____	<b>SB 31</b>	<b>BROWN, TROY</b>	<b>EDUCATION DEPARTMENT</b> Requires DOE to report annually specified information regarding the Student Scholarships for Educational Excellence Program to state legislators. (gov sig)
_____	<b>SB 36</b>	<b>BROWN, TROY</b>	<b>SCHOOLS</b> Requires notification to certain elected officials regarding submission and status of certain charter school applications. (gov sig)
_____	<b>SB 62</b>	<b>APPEL</b>	<b>POSTSECONDARY ED</b> Requires development and use of a common application for state public colleges and universities. (gov sig)
_____	<b>SB 98</b>	<b>NEVERS</b>	<b>TOPS</b> Provides that a five-point scale shall be used when calculating the grade point average for certain honors courses and talented courses. (gov sig)
_____	<b>SB 172</b>	<b>CORTEZ</b>	<b>TEACHERS</b> Provides relative to sick leave for teachers and other school employees. (8/1/14)
_____	<b>SB 312</b>	<b>CROWE</b>	<b>STUDENTS</b> Enacts the "Parents' Bill of Rights for Public Schools". (8/1/14)
_____	<b>SB 358</b>	<b>DONAHUE</b>	<b>COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES</b> Provides relative to the Louisiana Granting Resources and Autonomy for Diplomas Act to provide that certain high level autonomies relative to procurement apply to certain institutions under a shared service model. (8/1/14)
_____	<b>SB 366</b>	<b>CROWE</b>	<b>BESE</b> Requires BESE to develop a master plan for K-12 education. (8/1/14)

_____	<b>SB 533</b>	<b>LAFLEUR</b>	<b>EDUCATION DEPARTMENT</b> Provides for a local enrollment coordination process for publicly funded early childhood care and education. (gov sig)
_____	<b>SB 622</b>	<b>APPEL</b>	<b>SCHOOLS</b> Requires the Department of Education to develop and implement a statewide educational technology plan for public elementary and secondary schools. (8/1/14)
_____	<b>SB 683</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>SCHOOLS</b> Provides relative to student application and enrollment procedures in the Recovery School District and certain other school systems. (gov sig)
