 HCR 162	BARROW	CHILDREN/NEWBORNS Requests the Commission on Perinatal Care and Prevention of Infant Mortality to study and make recommendations concerning prevention and treatment of neonatal abstinence syndrome
 SB 158	HEITMEIER	MALPRACTICE Requires the reporting of malpractice claims paid by insurers or self-insurers on behalf of certain health care providers in an annual report to the Senate and House committees on health and welfare. (gov sig)
 SB 245	ERDEY	CHILDREN Provides for the reasonable and prudent parent standard and for certain considerations in foster care case plans and licensing requirements. (gov sig)
 SCR 34	HEITMEIER	HEALTH CARE Requests the Department of Health and Hospitals, the Department of Education, the Medicaid managed care organizations, and representatives of the Whole Child Initiative to work together to develop a plan to implement the Whole School, Whole Community, Whole Child model developed by the United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.
