_____	HCR 79	WHITE, MALINDA	DOMESTIC ABUSE Requests the Louisiana State Law Institute to study state laws governing domestic abuse, domestic violence, and stalking
_____	SCR 38	MORRELL	JUVENILE JUSTICE Creates the Task Force on Secure Care Standards and Auditing.
_____	SB 76	LAMBERT	CRIMINAL PROCEDURE Provides for venue in certain criminal cases. (gov sig)
_____	SB 128	MILKOVICH	CRIME/PUNISHMENT Prohibits cutting, resection, excision, harvesting, or removal of a body part, organ, or tissue of an aborted unborn child for sale, commerce, transport, research, or profit. (gov sig)
_____	SB 146	CLAITOR	CRIME/PUNISHMENT Provides relative to the Habitual Offender Law. (11/1/17)
_____	SB 163	MIZELL	CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES Provides an exemption from the requirement that state prisons purchase goods from Prison Enterprises, if the goods can be purchased for less in the parish in which the facility is located. (gov sig)
_____	SB 195	CORTEZ	ANIMALS Provides relative to the suspension of racing privileges. (8/1/17)
