_____	HB 111	MACK	CRIMINAL/RESTITUTION Provides relative to the payment of restitution to the victim of a crime
_____	HB 167	MACK	INDIGENT DEFENSE Provides relative to the disbursement of funds to district offices from the La. Public Defender Fund
_____	HB 200	WRIGHT	WEAPONS Repeals the prohibition on the manufacture, ownership, possession, custody, or use of certain knives and similar instruments
