_____	SB 261	ERDEY	PUBLIC EMPLOYEES Provides for certain insurance benefits for firemen and law enforcement officers who suffer a catastrophic injury resulting in permanent and total disability caused by an individual with the specific intent to kill an officer while the fireman or officer is engaged in the performance of his official duties. _____	SB 263	ERDEY	PUBLIC PROPERTY Constitutional amendment to permit the donation of the use of public equipment and personnel to the state or a political subdivision. (2/3 - CA13s1)
_____	HB 725	JAMES	CIVIL SERVICE/FIRE & POL Provides that the positions of police chief and deputy police chief in certain municipalities are in the unclassified service
