_____	SB 56	MILKOVICH	CIVIL PROCEDURE Provides right of an oral argument in contradictory proceedings.
_____	SB 60	MARTINY	DOMESTIC VIOLENCE Provides relative to civil actions for domestic abuse.
_____	SB 112	SMITH, G.	CIVIL PROCEDURE Authorizes business entities to assert or defend certain claims on their own behalf.
_____	SB 156	CARTER, T.	LIABILITY Provides immunity from liability for person providing gratuitous emergency care to a minor or domestic animal.
_____	SB 291	BARROW	FAMILY LAW Provides relative to family violence and domestic abuse as factors to consider in determining visitation and custody.

EXPROPRIATION Authorizes the expropriation of property including rights-of-way for use in certain projects in the city of Lafayette and parish of Lafayette.
