_____	<b>HB 277</b>	<b>MARCELLE</b>	<b>WEAPONS/FIREARMS</b> Prohibits the sale of assault rifles to any person under the age of twenty-one years
_____	<b>HB 486</b>	<b>SHADOIN</b>	<b>JUVENILE PROCEDURE</b> Provides relative to juvenile court jurisdiction
_____	<b>HB 525</b>	<b>BAGNERIS</b>	<b>DWI</b> Provides relative to the crime of operating a vehicle while intoxicated
_____	<b>HB 602</b>	<b>MIGUEZ</b>	<b>WEAPONS/FIREARMS</b> Provides relative to the carrying of a concealed handgun at a school
_____	<b>HB 611</b>	<b>JAMES</b>	<b>DRUGS/ILLEGAL</b> Establishes a civil penalty for marijuana possession
_____	<b>HB 630</b>	<b>HUNTER</b>	<b>HUMAN TRAFFICKING</b> Provides relative to the use of debt bondage to coerce a person to provide services or labor
_____	<b>HB 631</b>	<b>HUNTER</b>	<b>PARDON/PAROLE</b> Provides that a recommendation for clemency by the Board of Pardons does not expire upon the expiration of a governor's term in office
_____	<b>SCR 39</b>	<b>JOHNS</b>	<b>CHILDREN</b> Creates and provides for the Child Protection Act Advisory Commission.
_____	<b>SB 42</b>	<b>APPEL</b>	<b>CRIMINAL JUSTICE</b> Provides relative to making a false police report that triggers a law enforcement response ("swatting"). (gov sig)
_____	<b>SB 54</b>	<b>MARTINY</b>	<b>ARSON</b> Creates the crime of negligent arson. (gov sig)

_____	<b>SB 69</b>	<b>CLAITOR</b>	<b>CRIMINAL PROCEDURE</b> Provides for the in forma pauperis filing of expungements. (8/1/18)
_____	<b>SB 70</b>	<b>MIZELL</b>	<b>CRIMINAL PROCEDURE</b> Provides relative to permissible warrantless searches of the residences of defendants on probation or parole. (8/1/18)
_____	<b>SB 72</b>	<b>MARTINY</b>	<b>MENTAL HEALTH</b> Provides relative to the execution of an order for protective custody and examination. (gov sig)
_____	<b>SB 308</b>	<b>MIZELL</b>	<b>HEALTH SERVICES</b> Provides relative to the creation of a volunteer and employee criminal history system. (8/1/18)
_____	<b>SB 317</b>	<b>CLAITOR</b>	<b>PUBLIC DEFENDER</b> Provides procedure for expulsion of members of the Louisiana Public Defender Board for unexcused absences at board meetings. (gov sig)
_____	<b>SB 335</b>	<b>MIZELL</b>	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Provides for penalties for persons convicted for soliciting prostitutes. (8/1/18)
_____	<b>SB 384</b>	<b>CLAITOR</b>	<b>CRIMINAL RECORDS</b> Prohibits the commercial use of "mug shots" and other arrest records under certain circumstances. (8/1/18)
_____	<b>SB 402</b>	<b>RISER</b>	<b>WEAPONS</b> Clarifies that both volunteer and paid security guards may serve churches or houses of worship and provides for tactical training requirements for certain concealed handgun permittees. (8/1/18)
_____	<b>SB 471</b>	<b>RISER</b>	<b>CRIMINAL PROCEDURE</b> Provides relative to the functions of jury commissions in certain parishes. (8/1/18)
_____	<b>SB 473</b>	<b>JOHNS</b>	<b>LAW ENFORCEMENT</b> Authorizes Louisiana Property Assistance Agency to make surplus bulletproof vests available for purchase to certain part-time and reserve peace officers under the same requirements as the vests are made available to certain full-time employees. (8/1/18)
_____	<b>SB 558</b>	<b>BARROW</b>	<b>CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES</b> Provides relative to incarcerated women. (8/1/18)
